This poem concerns an incident, during the English Civil War, at the Battle of Worcester, where a certain young Royalist Captain of Horse, John Fitzwarren; with two of his Troopers, held off the Parliamentarian Essex Militia for some two hours at one of the City gates. Eventually overwhelmed, all three were put to the sword. Perhaps, these were his thoughts, prior to joining his Regiment.
